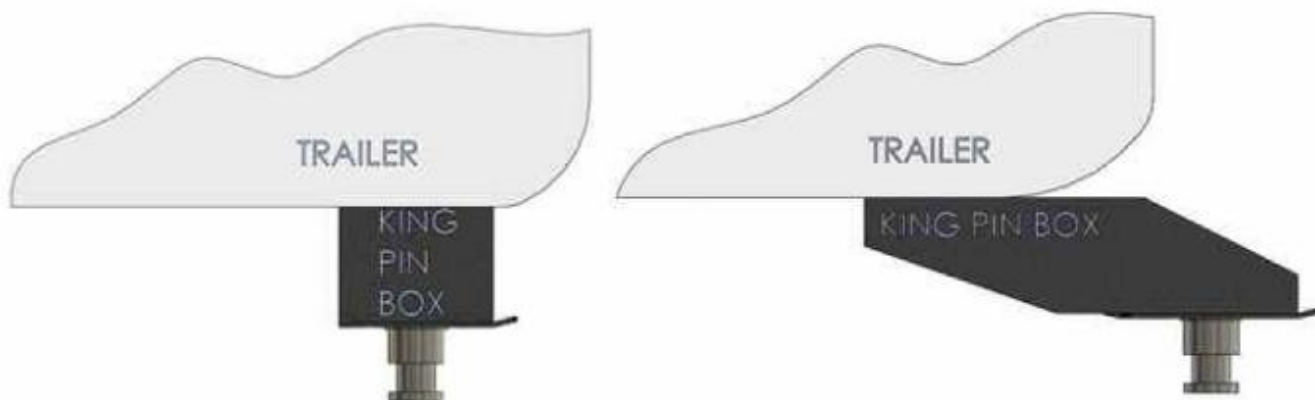
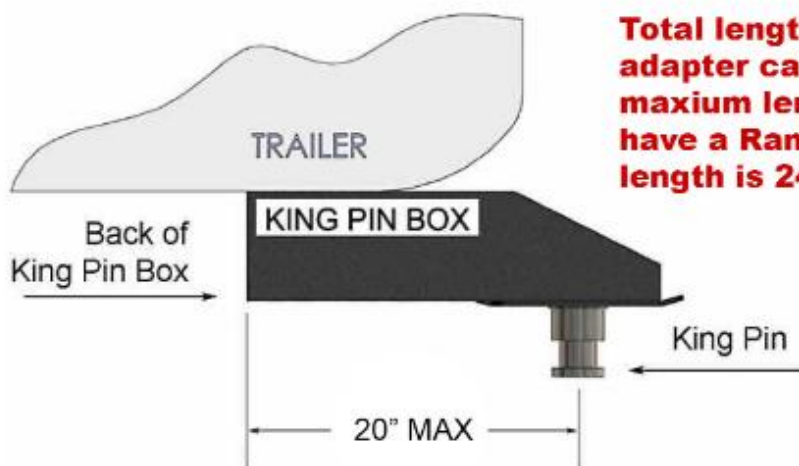


With a short bed truck, you typically need more room between the nose of the trailer and the cab of the truck. That's why we offer the different offsets. However you also need to make sure that the back of the king pin box will swing over the sides of the truck bed.



If the trailers king pin box is shaped like either of the above drawings there should be no problem adding the nine inch extension.

If it's shaped like the one below then the back of the box could hit the sides of the truck when turning.



**Total length of pin box and adapter can NOT exceed a maximum length of 30". If you have a Ram Box your maximum length is 24"**

This is a photo of a pin box that is so long and flat that it would hit the side rails of the truck with any kind of extension.
